

Desert Sky, a Quiltworx Project with Ann Troutman

Desert Sky is designed as a paper piecing project by Quiltworx. Finishing at 48in X 54in, it is a great starter project. It is also Fat Quarter friendly so grab your favorite bundle and join Certified Quiltworx instructor, Ann Troutman to make this great, quick project!

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Supplies:

- Pattern from Inspire! – **Desert Star by Quiltworx** (includes paper foundations)
- Fabric as indicated on pattern back (see next page) – colors are your choice
- Scissors – both paper and fabric
- Rotary cutter and extra blades
- Add-A-Quarter Ruler 12" or 18"
- 6" X 18" ruler and medium cutting mat
- Seam Ripper
- Scotch Tape
- Fabric Glue Stick &/or Glue Pen (we like Sewline or Bohin)
- High quality cotton thread 50 or 60 weight (we like Aurifil) in a neutral color
- Large uncoated paper clips (lots)
- Gallon baggies & Sharpie marker
- Flower Head pins
- Sewing machine in good working order with ¼" foot, power cord, foot pedal

Optional but good to have:

- Purple Thang
- Size 70/10 Microtex or Sharp needles
- Ink pen or pencil
- Personal iron and pressing surface

Prework:

- Cut out all of the paper foundations ¼" outside marked lines.
- Refer to pattern instructions for numbering bags and what goes in which bag.
- Are you prewashing? Wash and press all of it. *Never start a project with some pieces washed and some not.* Iron with sizing, starch or Best Press will give the best results

Bradley and Judy Niemeyer designed the layout for Desert Sky using a collection of bright and dark fat quarters designed by Island Batik. Template Layouts Sheets were designed and provided with these instructions to speed up the cutting process, allowing you to stack and cut your fat quarters in two groups of nine fabrics. An even amount of yardage is needed for each color. This small wall hanging is definitely one to add to your collection. The skill level ranges from beginner to advanced.

Yardage

Choose twelve (12) light and medium light textured batiks:
Cut one 18" by 21" fat quarter from each color:

Choose twelve (12) dark and medium dark textured batiks:
Cut one 18" by 21" fat quarter from each color:

Backing and Binding: 3 Yards

Extra foundation packages will be sold separately for this quilt. These packages can be used to expand this layout or build a second quilt top. The extra foundation packages will only include the foundation papers. Yardages requirements and layouts will not be included with the extra foundation papers. However, yardage can be estimated by using the formula below for the blocks.

One (1) Fat-Quarter will provide enough fabric to make Two (2) blocks.
Add a few extra fat quarters as fill-ins for the additional background and border blocks.
